

Basic policy for the recruitment of permanent researchers

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As a comprehensive research institute of science and technology for disaster risk reduction, National Research Institute for Earth Science and Disaster Resilience (NIED) seeks to recruit highly qualified personnel with the aim of flexibly responding to evolving circumstances surrounding disaster risk reduction, strengthening national resilience and ultimately contributing to the creation of a sustainable society, and generating outstanding research outcomes in accordance with the national policy while reinforcing the foundation for proactive engagement in transdisciplinary research and social collaboration.

In the recruitment of permanent research staff, NIED seeks individuals who can play leading roles in major research programs/projects and have the potential to assume future management responsibilities at the institute. In principle, such positions are widely advertised in accordance with NIED's open recruitment guidelines, and candidates are selected through a fair and impartial screening process.

In addition, contract researchers who have been employed through open recruitment and selected through a fair and impartial screening process may be appointed as permanent research staff, based on their research achievements and other relevant factors.
